## Official Minutes of the Monticello Community School District Board of Education Special Meeting of October 13, 2021

The Board of Education Special Meeting was held in the Board Room at the High School at 850 East Oak Street, Monticello, Iowa on Wednesday, October 13, 2021. The Special Meeting was called to order at 6:00pm by President Craig Stadtmueller. Stadtmueller also led the Pledge of Allegiance and read the Monticello CSD mission statement.
